## July 1, 2022

Administrative Account: \$10,390.79

- We collected dues so far from 45 members.
- We deposited \$512 from payments for dinners and raffles at meeting of June 21.
- We paid \$682 to Prime Minister for meals for meeting of June 21
- Administrative Checking Account Balance was \$15,801 at beginning of fiscal year.
- We made a donation of \$395 for a tree at Grafton Lion's Park in memory of Dan Harris.
- We paid \$117 for metal plates for plaques to Lion's presidents to Recognition Specialists.

Activity Account: \$16,736. Previous balance on 5/31/2022 was \$10,818.90

- Profits after expenses for Chicken Roast was \$5632.
- We collected \$1,334 from sales at Centennial Park. With expenses we are currently \$72.39 for Centennial Park.
- We received \$100 from Race Day Events as a donation directed to Lions from volunteers for a race day event.

## FOUR MORE TREES ADDED TO GRAFTON LIONS PARK

The Grafton Lions Club and the Village of Grafton will plant four more trees in Grafton Lions Park on Tuesday, June 28<sup>th</sup>. Each tree will add color and shade to the 16-acre park along Cedar Creek and Keup Road, just south of highway 60. The trees include a Shagbark Hickory, a Sugar Maple and two Tulip trees. Each was purchased from Johnson's Nursery and is well suited for parks and Wisconsin weather. This brings the number of trees planted by the Club at the park to 45 per Dave Mauer, Lions Park Chairman.

Lions Park is relatively new to the eighteen parks in the Village of Grafton. In 2000, it was farmland. The Village received the 16 acres in 2001. The Grafton Lions Club purchased naming rights shortly after raising \$75,000.00 through donations from individuals, local business, and Corporations. The following year, the Grafton Lions Club raised an additional \$50,000.00 through separate donations for playground equipment. The Grafton Lions followed up by building a beautiful Pavilion through separate donations and spent weekends building the roof. The Village of Grafton, Public Works Dept. the Park and Recreation Dept. and the Lions had a great partnership getting these projects completed.

In 2019, The Grafton Lions Club committed \$50,000.00 over ten years to add an Exercise/fitness station, a Canoe/kayak pier on Cedar Creek, a cement patio and additional park benches and picnic tables. Plans are currently being made with Chad Hoier, Director of Parks and Recreation and Jake Arndt, Superintendent of Public Works to install some of the new equipment this year.

If you have not paid Lion's Park a visit, you should do so. It is a gem in the Village of Grafton's Park system.
