I am a certified vision screening trainer for District 27-A2, so I will be having a training, hopefully, sometime in September. If you are interested in being trained on both the charts and the machines, watch for the training date.

We will once again have the opportunity to help the District vision screen in Milwaukee. Watch for those dates if you would like to help.
