Dues

Increase Starting with the next Lionistic year the Grafton Lions will increase dues to \$85 per year. Lions International will be increasing dues \$7 over the next three years. That combined with the fact that the District raised dues \$3 three years ago, it necessitated an increase in our dues of \$10. The board voted on this at the March BOD meeting. Rather than raise our dues incrementally over the next couple of years, it was determined it would be best to do one increase this year. This will allow us to recoup the increase by the District that we did not pass along at that time.

Did you know this about Grafton Lions Park?

The land, 16 acres, was once part of the Kohlwey Homestead on Keup Road, bordered by Cedar Creek and Hwy 60. In early 2000, The Village of Grafton purchased this property from the Kohlwey family. The Village of Grafton intended to use this land as a Park. The development cost for this new park project came in at \$300,000.00. The sources for funding came from the State of Wisconsin - \$150,000.00, The Village of Grafton - \$75,000.00 and the sale of name rights - \$75,000.00.

In late 2004, the Grafton Lions Club was made aware of the naming rights opportunity. In early 2005, the Club approved buying those rights and committed \$75,000.00 over a 15 year period, towards the purchase of the naming rights. To get the Club's approval, it was agreed that this fund raising effort would remain separate from all other annual Club fund donations to worthy causes. With that agreement in place, the Club signed the Village note. In 18 months, 75,000.00 was raised.

In late 2006, the Grafton Lions Club was approached by the Village to purchase playground equipment for the new Lions Park at a cost of \$50,000.00. Our Club again came forward and committed to raise \$50,000.00 over a 10 year period. The 10 year note was paid off in 4 years. In the summer of 2010, our Club agreed to help the Village construct a new pavilion for the Park. The effort got started in Fall with our Club raising \$8,150.00, plus two of our Club members provided an In-Kind donation architectural services from their company, New Horizon Ventures. The Village took care of the cement slab, block, electrical and water connections. 38 members of our club donated all the carpentry work, roofing, installing the lighting and painting. Heavy lifting equipment was donated by a Lion member to lift the support beams in place. In the Spring of 2012, the Grafton Lions hosted a Grand Opening of the Park, serving food, beverages, music and good fellowship.

From 2006 to the present, our Club and many good friends of our Park donated money toward the purchase 45 trees, installed two flower beds, 5 park benches and 3 metal picnic tables. The

average cost of a tree was \$350.00 or \$15,750.00. The 5 park benches came to \$4,000.00 and the three picnic tables came to \$4500.00.

In April 2019, the Grafton Lions Club approved a \$50,000.00, ten year plan to fund

- 1. Exercise/Fitness Station along the walking path in the Park.
- 2. A Canoe/Kayak Pier on Cedar Creek bordering our Park.
- 3. An additional slab next to the Pavilion for party tents.
- 4. Additional metal picnic tables.
- 5. Additional Park benches.

Our Club signed a note with the Village and pays off \$5000.00 per year.
