The Centennial Park committee provides on the job training for all first-time workers as well as remedial training as needed. You need to be at the park by 6:00 p.m. and may be there until 10:00 p.m. depending on the number of games. You will need to pick up the cash bag and keys at the Port Washington State Bank branch on Cheyenne Avenue and Hwy. 60 prior to going to the park. You also need to return the cash bag to the bank after you volunteer for the next night.

Volunteer signup will be done online using Signup Genius again this year. You can refer to the Signup Genius web site to see when you volunteer. You will receive an e-mail reminder a week before your scheduled time. When there are two people scheduled to volunteer on a Thursday night they need to coordinate who picks up and returns the cash bag.

## SIX MORE TREES FOR LIONS PARK

THANKS TO A FEW LIONS MEMBERS AND SOME ANONYMOUS DONORS, THE GRAFTON LIONS PARK WILL RECEIVE SIX MORE BEAUTIFUL SHADE TREES IN APRIL OR MAY. WE DECIDED TO PURCHASE DIFFERENT VARIETIES THIS YEAR IN AN EFFORT TO DIVERSIFY. EACH TREE WILL ADD COLOR AND SHADE TO OUR 16 ACRE PARK ALONG KEUP ROAD. THIS WILL BRING THE NUMBER OF TREES PLANTED BY LIONS AND FRIENDS OF THE PARK TO 40.

THE TREES WERE PURCHASED FROM JOHNSON'S NURSERY AT THEIR JACKSON LOCATION. THE VARIETIES INCLUDE THREE HYBRID BUR OAK, ONE NORTHERN CATALPA (SPRING FLOWERS) AND TWO EARLY GLOW BUCKEYE TREES (FALL ORANGE/RED LEAVES). THE COST FOR THE TREES CAME TO \$1,572.00. YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED OF THE DATE AND TIME OF PLANTING.

FOR THOSE LION MEMBERS THAT ARE FAIRLY NEW TO THE CLUB, YOUR GRAFTON LIONS CLUB HAS BEEN ACTIVE IN DEVELOPING THE PARK SINCE 2004, WHEN IT PURCHASED NAMING RIGHTS FOR THE SITE. SINCE THEN, THE LIONS HAVE RAISED ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR THE PARK PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT, THE PAVILION, FLOWER BEDS, BENCHES AND PICNIC TABLES. OUR CLUB AND THE VILLAGE OF GRAFTON RECENTLY SIGNED A TEN YEAR/FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLAR AGREEMENT WHERE THE LIONS WILL DONATE AND THE VILLAGE WILL INSTALL AN EXERCISE/FITNESS STATION (\$30,000.00), A CANOE/KAYAK PIER ON CEDAR CREEK (\$5,000.00), PARK BENCHES (\$3,750.00), PICNIC TABLES (\$3,000.00), A CEMENT OR STONE PATIO NEXT TO THE PAVILION FOR TENTS (\$10,000.00) AND ADDITIONAL PARK TREES. THE EQUIPMENT WILL BE INSTALLED IN EARLY 2021 IN TIME FOR OUR CLUB'S 75TH YEAR AS AN ORGANIZATION IN GRAFTON.
