Treasurer John Krueger reported the following December 31, 2019 account balances:

The Grafton Lions currently have \$37,872.57 in the Activity Account and \$15,512.96 in the Administrative Account. We have income of \$19,846.88 from fundraisers so far this year compared to projected income from fundraisers of \$19,250. We have made donations of \$14,750 so far. Pending donations are to Grafton Lions Park, Zone Project and Scholarships along with insurance costs.

Remaining fund raiser for this year is 9-pin tap bowling which is budgeted to make \$4,000.
